Online Learning Sessions

Level 2 Food Safety and Hygiene (2-3 hours self-learning during April)

FREE accredited Level 2 Food Safety and Hygiene courses for VCSE organisations operating in South Devon providing emergency food for families/children or vulnerable people in South Devon, suitable for volunteers and paid staff who have access to the internet.

The Course is suitable for food banks, community larders, community fridge projects, organisations providing meals, lunch clubs, community centres, playgroups, after-school clubs etc. Certificate on completion.

GDPR and Data Protection Refresher 6th May 10.00am – 1.00pm

This session looks at what voluntary organisations should be doing to make sure that they comply with GDPR and review what they have done so far. It includes questions around marketing and fundraising – and the issue of consent. It is suitable for those with no previous experience as well as those wanting to catch up or refresh their knowledge and includes:

- What is Data Protection?
- The UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
- Finding the correct legal basis for your use of people's data
- The six Data Protection principles
- How to provide people with the right information and options
- Avoiding the kind of mistakes that generate complaints
- Plus opportunity to submit your individual questions

Level 2 Infection Control training *Monday 17 May 9.30 – 12.30*

A FREE course for VCS groups in Teignbridge/South Devon and particularly relevant during and post COVID.

Infection control and prevention is essential for organisations where work activities could put employees at risk of passing on or contracting an infection. This includes working in a healthcare environment, in close contact with people or animals, and cleaning of waste. Infections are easily passed on, but equally easy to avoid if everyone on the premises takes proper preventative action.

This online infection control course covers the sources of microorganisms and how infectious bacteria transfer between hosts. Learners will understand the process of preventing infections from spreading. This includes proper hand washing procedures, wound dressing, cleaning activities, and waste disposal.
